a Linear Progression Harm Minimisation Chatterbox

- 1. Imagine four fictional school students. Then at each corner of the chatterbox write an attribute about the student, an action or a fact e.g. happy, serious, leader, new student
- **2.** In *triangles 1-8* write down a place where your student might hang out or be doing something e.g. waiting for a bus, in the school yard
- **3.** In *triangles marked 'a'* you need to write down something that might happen in each of the places that your student finds themselves in e.g. being teased by other students.
- **4.** In *Triangles marked 'b'* write down the possible outcomes or effects of the actions to each of the student scenarios you have created.

## 5. Fold & Fiddle & Colour.

Then as a class or in small groups discuss what strategies could be used to prevent, reduce or overcome any outcomes from the scenarios you have created.
