

MEANingFUL IPSO

Generic Chatterbox

This cross linking chatter box helps to facilitate classroom discussions about issues that could affect a student's wellbeing.

Take four fictional secondary school students and divide them into four generic groupings as

Individuals

putting them into eight different

Places

facing eight different

Situations

each leading to an individual

Outcome

that will provide them with a personal snapshot of their school day.

Understanding the consequences of student's behaviour is very important as different actions can impact upon any one of the *IPSO* scenarios

Develop a classroom version of this chatterbox (on the reverse side of this page) by selecting a topic and then referring to the example opposite (in this case students selected the topic of bullying).

Then follow these

instructions to develop a Cross Linking MEANingFUL IPSO generic chatterbox

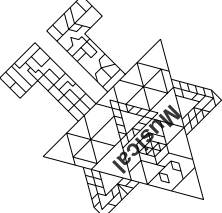
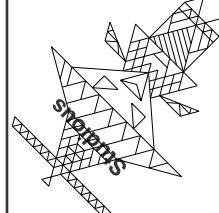
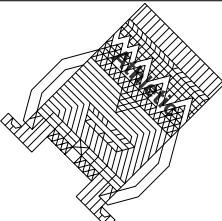
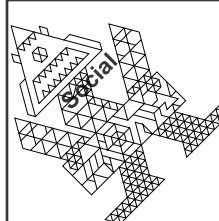
1. At each corner of the chatterbox write something about the student, an action or a fact e.g. really good at playing sport.

2. In *triangles 1-8* write down two places where the student might hang out or be doing something e.g. playing soccer on the oval.

3. In *triangles marked 'a'* you need to write down something that might happen in each of the places that the student finds themselves in e.g. being teased by other students.

4. In *Triangles marked 'b'* write down the likely harmful or positive outcomes/effects of the actions to each student of the scenarios you have created.

5. Tasks. As a class or in small groups discuss what strategies could be used to prevent/reduce/encourage any outcomes from the scenarios you have created.
